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### Activities

- Both the boy and the dog are distracted by things that they see. The dog really wants to chase the butterfly. When you go on a walk with your child, observe people and their dogs and point out the dogs that are distracted.
- One of the items that the boy was suppose to buy was "a cake for tea." Have "tea" with your child by serving a light snack around four o'clock in the afternoon.
- The next time you go grocery shopping, encourage your child to make out the list. Each time you find an item, have your child cross it out on the list.
