## Five Little Monkeys Jumping on the Bed

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### Activities

- This is a counting book. Play with toys, food, and people by counting each object one through five and then five back down to one.
- The monkeys in the book jump on a bed. It's not a good idea for your child to jump on a bed (he or she could tumble off), but encourage him or her to jump outside. Can he or she jump long? Jump short? Play with your child outside.
- Encourage your child to pretend to be a doctor. What would the "doctor" say to the toys who are "hurt"?
