Maisy's Bedtime

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Activities

- Identify key words in the story (e.g., bedroom, sleep, potty) and teach their signs to your child.
- Read this story to your child before getting ready for bed. Make a checklist with pictures of the different steps in getting ready for bed. Cut out stars and let your child paste or tape a star on the checklist next to each step accomplished.
- Ask your child to list the things that Maisy does to prepare for bed and to write them down on a piece of paper. Sign the steps on the list with your child. Keep the sentences short and add pictures or drawings next to them. Tape the list near your child's bed or in the bathroom as a reminder.
