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Activities

- A part of this story is told in the pictures of what happens to the fox as he follows Rosie. Tell the story of "Mr. Fox Goes for a Walk" from the perspective of the fox.
- This story takes place on a farm. If you are driving through the countryside, allow some extra time to stop by the side of the road and look at the different buildings, equipment, and animals found on a farm.
- Compare the various sizes of flour in the grocery store and find out how many pounds of flour come in each size. Guess how many pounds of flour were in the sack in the story.
